

How to Set a Mastery Score Using Adaptive Release

Adaptive Release rules allow you to set specific rules, such as achieving an 80% on a pre-test in order to move on to the module content.

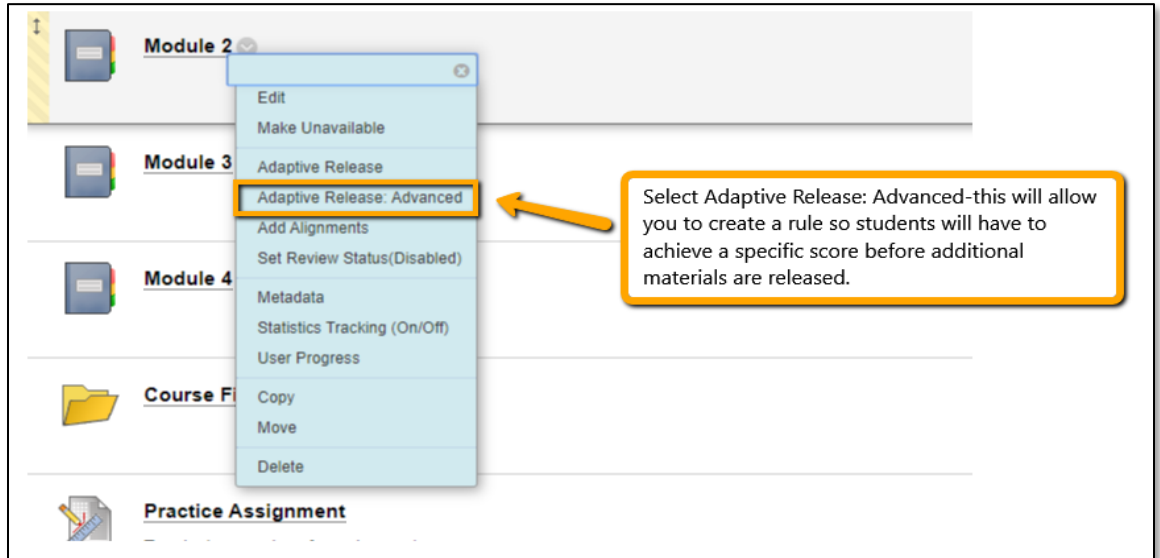
Item Location and Menu Selection

1. Determine which module the quiz will live.






2. Hover on the chevron

3. Select **Adaptive Release: Advanced**

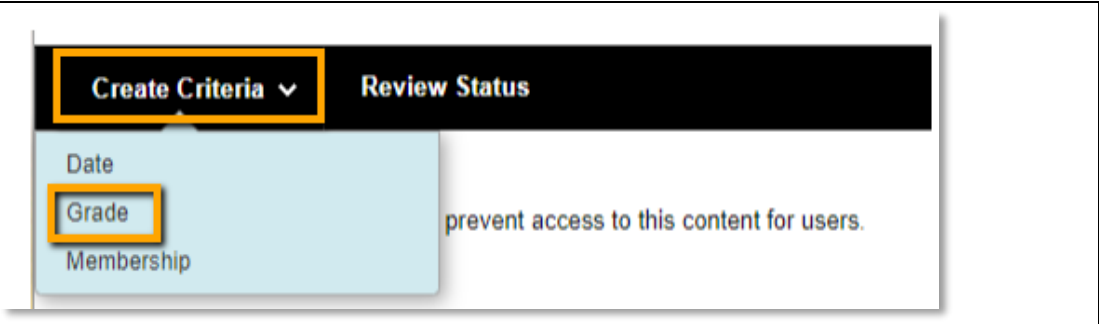


4. Click on the link to go to the next screen to create the rule.

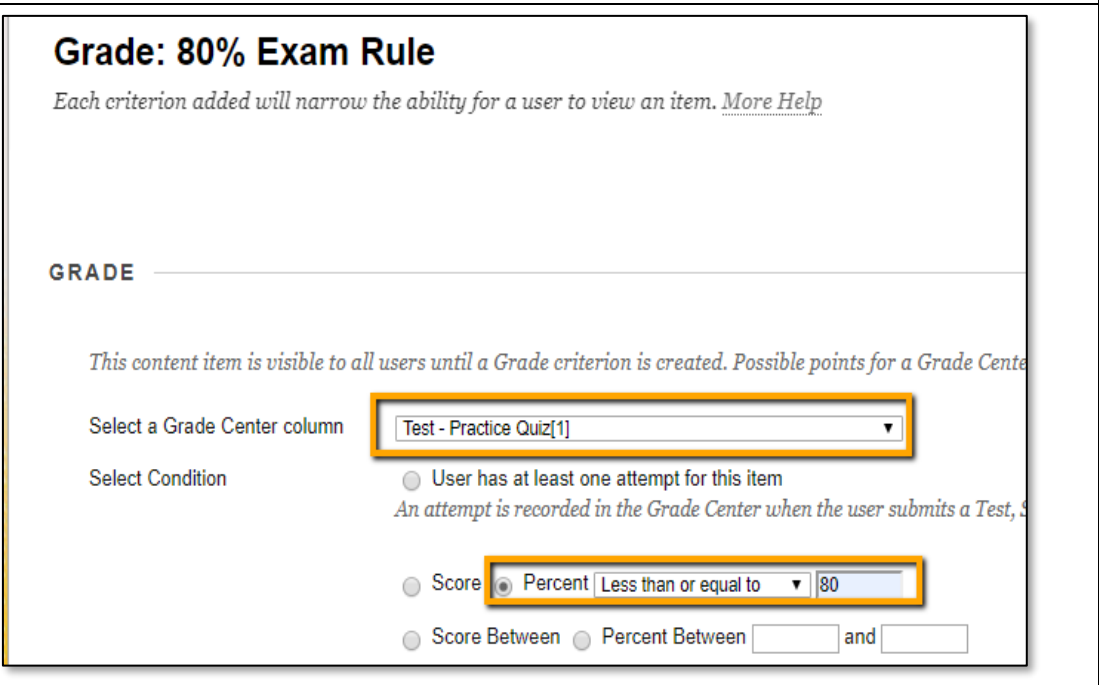
Setting the Rule

1. Select Create Rule

5. Next select **Grade**



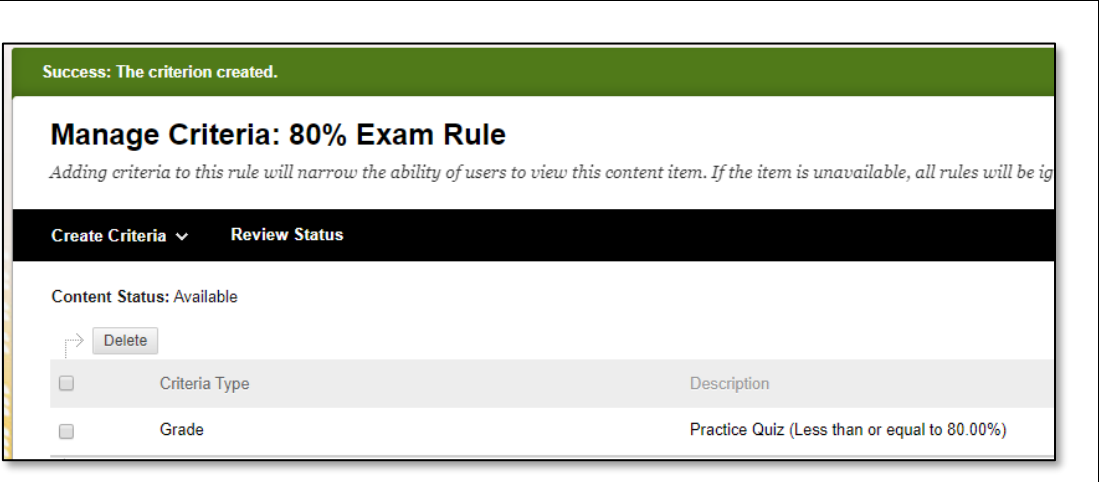
6. Select the **Grade Center Column**

This example shows 80%, you may determine a specific percentage and if user has more than one attempt.



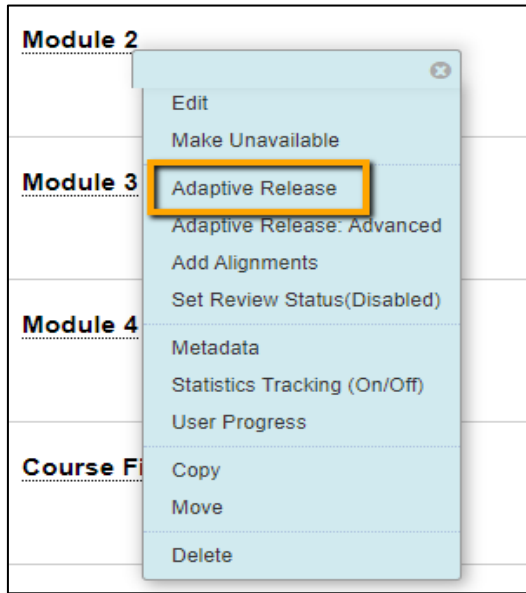
8. Click **Submit**
