<b>Pledge</b>	<b>Related Pillar</b>	<b>Ways students can demonstration</b>
Gratitude in the Workplace (#1)	Positive Attitude	Positive attitude towards others opinions. Practicing effective teamwork. Not demonstrating entitlement towards others. Expressing appreciate for others actions, ideas, and opinions. Working to resolve conflict.
Pursuit of Happiness (#2)	Positive Attitude Personal Responsibility Delayed Gratification	Identifying goals and working through challenges that jeopardize completion of their goals. Establishing individual definition of happiness. Seeking solutions to problems that derail progress towards goals.
Jobs are Opportunities (#3)	Personal Responsibility	Seeking opportunities to do more. Working to complete all assignments on time. Understand each requirement is towards their goal, whether it's enjoyable or not.
Value in the Workplace (#4)	Positive Attitude Personal Responsibility	Connecting personal values to work in the classroom. Bringing passion to any level of work they engage in.
Deploring Debt (#5)	Personal Responsibility Delayed Gratification	Taking responsibility for their actions. Demonstrating contentment with current status and not putting themselves in situations they are not ready for.
Personal Safety (#6)	Personal Responsibility	Taking responsibility for personal safety in all situation. Demonstrating understanding for safety protocol, including themselves and others.

Pledge	Related Pillar	Ways students can demonstration
Distinguish Myself (#7)	Positive Attitude Delayed Gratification Work Ethic	Students distinguish themselves in the classroom through maintaining a positive attitude, seeking new opportunities to learn, demonstrating respect and courtesy for others, and routinely complete projects on time. Showing up on time, being prepared to learn.
Whining and Complaining (#8)	Positive Attitude	Leading with a positive attitude, avoiding the pitfall of whining and complaining.
Lifelong Learning (#9)	Personal Responsibility	Engaging in opportunity to learn more and from others around them. Learning isn't always formal, seeking "outside the box" opportunities. Demonstrating an understanding of content and asking questions when they don't.
Choices, Not Circumstances (#10)	Positive Attitude Personal Responsibility Delayed Gratification	Not letting circumstances (money, status, family) dictate what they can do. Positive choices lead to new circumstances.
Resenting Others (#11)	Positive Attitude Delayed Gratification	Satisfaction with what they have and not resenting others for what they may have around them. Outcomes are earned by the effort they give. The world is not fair and that's ok.
Work My Butt Off (#12)	Positive Attitude Work Ethic	Students work hard, even when it's hard. They work to motivate others to work hard as well. Hard work results in positive outcomes.

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
